CADENCES

Cadence = a chord progression and harmonic configuration that creates a sense of closure (at the end of a phrase)

- AUTHENTIC (closed, final, full, full close) cadence AC = V I or IV V I
 - perfect authentic PAC chords in root position, highest note is the tonic
 - imperfect authentic IAC all other V-I that are not PAC
 - root position IAC highest note is NOT the tonic
 - inverted IAC at least one chord is inverted
 - leading tone IAC V is replaced by vii
 - evaded cadence: V2 to I6
- HALF CADENCE (open, imperfect, semi-cadence, half close) cadence = ending in V
 - Phrygian half cadence iv6 to V in minor with an upper leading note
 - Lydian cadence #iv6 to V in minor
 - Burgundian cadence (???)
- PLAGAL CADENCE = IV I
- DECEPTIVE CADENCE (interrupted, false close) cadence = V to anywhere else
 BUT I, most commonly V-vi in major or V-VI in minor
